*Fill in the new Personal Details Form thingy and get it back to John and Penny by the first Sunday in July. ✓*

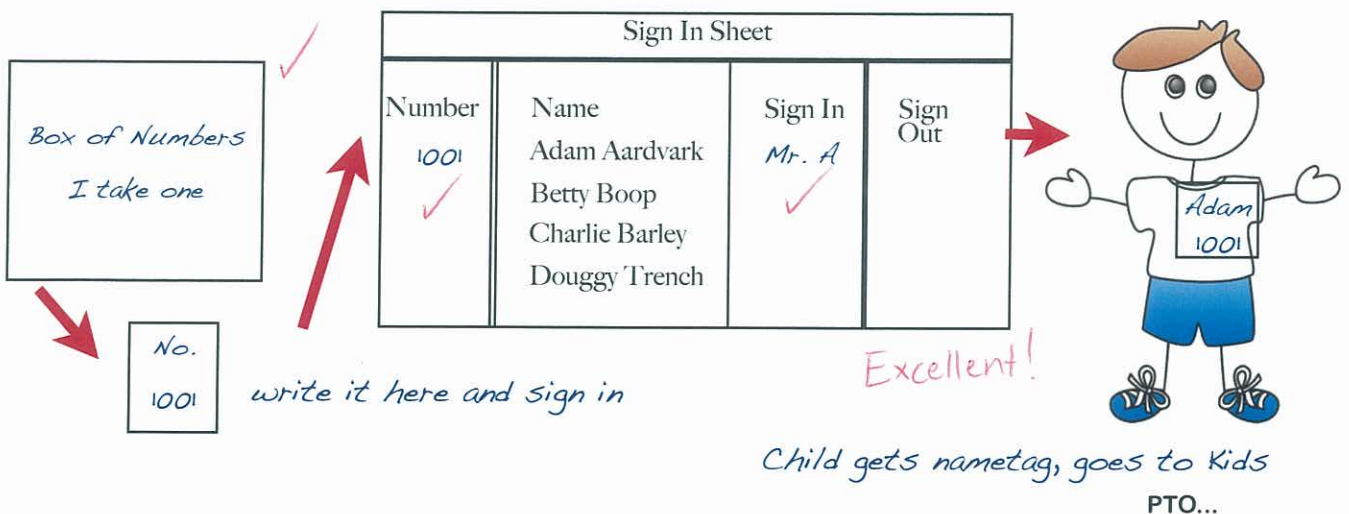
2. Describe the new "Number Tag" System.

*Each child that gets signed into KidsChurch, KinderChurch or ToddlerChurch gets a number for that day. When I sign in my child, I pick a number card, write that number on the Sign In sheet and they get that number written on their name tag. Then when I come back to sign them out, I have to have the number card to get my child back. ✓ Good!*

3. Where should you go to sign in your kids for DaySpring Kids?

*KidsChurch and KinderChurch near the front door, and they will have A-K and L-Z tables. ToddlerChurch in their new room. Its easy, there are lots of good signs about, and nice people at the Information counter. ✓*

*It means I need to go to the kids area of that child, perhaps because they are having a wobbly, needs a nappy change or just miss me! ✓*

7. When do the sign ins happen for DaySpring Kids?

*All areas will now sign in during the break, after the Insider video. The KidsChurch age group that used to sign in at the door before church now sign in at the break too. For the other ages, its the same as before. ✓*

8. Why are the doors on the Kids areas so significant?

*The doors are really helpful in letting us know if the kids are finished doing church in their room. If the doors are closed, they are still going. If the doors are open, they are all done and its OK for me to go in and sign my child out. ✓ Great!*

8A. What should parents do if they know they will have to leave early or right at the end of church?

*Tell the Kids Leader at sign in time so they can keep an eye out for me. ✓*

8B. What about if something unexpected comes up?

*If the Kids area doors are still closed, its OK to knock but I should be sensitive to what is happening inside. ✓*

9. Describe the Nursery area?

*Its a great place! Mum's or Dad's can take their babies there to feed or cry or play in comfort without being worried about disturbing church. You can even hear the message in there. Also there is a DaySpring Kids person there who will love on the babies, pray over them and if its appropriate look after the bub and release the parents to go back into church.
